MAAPE Announces 2017 Award Recipients

LANCASTER, PA – The Mid-Atlantic Alliance for Performance Excellence (MAAPE) is pleased to announce that six organizations from three different industry sectors will receive recognition at its 12th Annual Awards Banquet & Conference in November. MAAPE, a 501(c)3 organization serving PA, NJ, and DE, is one of 31 state and regional Baldrige-based award programs across the country.

MAAPE applicants are evaluated in seven areas defined by the Baldrige Criteria: leadership; strategy; customers; measurement, analysis, and knowledge management; workforce; operations, and results. All applicants receive written feedback reports summarizing organizational strengths and opportunities for improvement.

The following three organizations will receive the Excellence Award, MAAPE's highest level of recognition. The Excellence Award recognizes applicants that demonstrate -- through practices and results -- superior levels of performance excellence. These applicants are outstanding examples in the Mid-Atlantic Region and serve as role models for other organizations. A site visit is required to qualify for the Excellence Award.
